Practice Registration

Role Overview:

Volunteers at practice registration are responsible for checking in riders for scheduled practice sessions.


This is often the first point of contact for participants, so a friendly and organized approach is key.

Key Duties:

Greet riders and check them off registration lists
Confirm payment or registration status if required
Distribute practice wristbands or passes
Provide directions or basic event information
Coordinate with the registration lead for any issues

Ideal For:

Organized individuals with good communication skills and a welcoming attitude.





Pens (Staging Area)

Role Overview:

The pens (or staging area) are where riders are organized into their motos (heats) before moving to the start gate. Volunteers here help maintain order and ensure riders are in the correct lanes.

Key Duties:

Direct riders to the correct pen/lane based on moto sheets
Confirm rider numbers and categories
Keep the staging area safe and orderly
Liaise with the gate crew to ensure smooth transitions

Ideal For:

People who are confident giving directions and can manage a fast-paced environment.





Flags (Track Spotters)

Role Overview:

Flag volunteers act as safety spotters around the track. They watch for crashes or hazards and use flags to signal riders and officials.

Key Duties:

Hold and wave flags to alert riders in case of accidents Monitor assigned section of the track attentively Communicate with first aid or race control if needed Clear minor debris or notify officials of any track issues

Ideal For:

Alert individuals who can stay focused for extended periods and respond quickly to situations.





Track (Picker Uppers)

Role Overview:

Track volunteers help fallen riders to their feet and safely off the track. This role is hands-on and involves light physical work.

Key Duties:

Assisting fallen riders

Communicating with flag bearers/ track spotters

Support safety checks before and during race sessions

Ideal For:

Active volunteers who enjoy being outdoors and don't mind getting their hands dirty.





Gate

(Start Gate Operation Support)

Role Overview:

Gate volunteers assist with the operation of the starting gate and ensure riders are safely and fairly launched for each race.

Key Duties:

Help riders line up on the gate in correct order Confirm race category with the staging team Communicate with the starter and gate operator Ensure all riders are ready before the gate drops

Ideal For:

Detail-oriented people comfortable with working close to equipment and under time pressure.
